### 6. Principal's Report: Karen Chan

CBE Video Surveillance Technology project: the cameras are being refreshed with a new system, this is required by CBE, it will require new electrical cable wiring, these cameras will be much higher quality than what is currently installed, video footage is used under the authority of the education act, the cameras are not hidden, will be installed in plain view, there is no audio recording, cameras are focussed on CBE property only, not external buildings, cameras will be installed inside the building and on the outside of the building, there are no cameras in washrooms or stairwells, there is a not a hard date as to when this upgrade will happen, a discussion was held about the cameras

Update on the portables: hopeful project will be ready for second semester. Languages classes will be moving out there.

CTS Digital pathways project: still in phase 1, 3 new classrooms being built, hoping that this project will be done in the next 2-3 weeks

Second floor emergency exits and stairs, should be completed by end of November

Upcoming projects: Phase 2 of CTS digital pathways will begin once phase 1 is completed

Outcomes Based Assessment Parent Session was well attended.

Cell phone policy: no phones in class, the departments in the school each have developed their own policy for storage of phones in class
